



This year JSS participants will be permitted to wear the official Junior Solar Sprint T-shirt to the time trials and semifinals event (only) at the 2018 national TSA conference in Atlanta, Georgia.

**Show off your creativity!**

Enter the JSS T-shirt Design Challenge and your design could be chosen as the official T-shirt for the JSS event at the 2018 national TSA conference.

Participants may choose to wear either the JSS T-shirt or the official TSA competition attire at the JSS time trials and semifinals events.

T-shirts will be distributed to each participating team member in the JSS event at the 2018 national TSA conference. Specific details will be provided prior to the conference.

**Eligibility:**

One (1) entry per chapter; one (1) entry per team; one (1) design per team

**How to enter:**

1. Team entries should be submitted to Maria Raza, [mraza@tsaweb.org](mailto:mraza@tsaweb.org), with your school and chapter advisor's name in the subject line of the email. Design entry must be submitted by April 13, 2018.
2. Entries received, or changes made to submitted entries after this deadline will not be judged.
3. An email verification will be sent for each submitted entry.

**Procedure:**

Any additional information about design work needs to be typed and saved as a separate PDF file, and submitted with the design PDF files. Include the following only if it applies to your submitted design:

- Cite all ideas, fonts and images from sources other than the designer, and/or that are copyrighted (most fonts and images found on the web are copyrighted material unless purchased or offered as free-domain).
- If copyrighted material is used, written permission must be included (See attached Student Copyright Checklist)
- If the entry contains images of people, proof of consent must be included as a separate PDF file and submitted with other required files. Images of minors require parental consent (See Photo/Film/Video Consent and Release in the Forms Appendix)

**What you win:**

1. The winning design will be featured on the back of the official JSS event T-shirt at the 2018 national TSA conference.
2. The winning team will also receive a \$100 coupon to the TSA store.

**Contest Guidelines:**

1. Design must be made for the back of the shirt only, can include only two (2) colors and may not exceed 8 ½" by 11" in size.

2. Design must be sent in a high resolution PDF file.
3. All entries must be original creations. Participants must follow the TSA competitive event general rules G and H as stated below:
  - G. Citations, References and Copyright:
    1. For all applicable competitive events, citations or references must follow MLA (Modern Language Association) style.
    2. All entries must be the original work of the student participant or student team.
    3. All ideas, text, images, and sound from other sources must be cited.
    4. If copyrighted material is used, written permission must be included.
      - a. An Internet search about copyrighted material and copyright fair use is recommended if ideas, text, images, or sound from other sources is incorporated into an event entry.
      - b. For information about the use of the TSA logo, see the TSA website at <http://www.tsaweb.org/Trademark-Policies>.
    5. Failure to follow any of the above procedures results in disqualification.
  - H. Prohibited Materials, References, and Images:
    1. Competition entries or presentations by participants must not include racial or ethnic slurs/symbols, reference to gang affiliation, or vulgar, violent, subversive, or sexually suggestive language or images.
    2. Entries or presentations may not promote products that students may not legally buy, such as tobacco, alcohol, or illegal drugs.
    3. Images of guns, knives, or other weapons are prohibited.
    4. Failure to follow any of the above procedures results in disqualification.
4. The design must symbolize the JSS program experience for all students and may contain references to the 2018 national TSA conference in Atlanta. No references to a specific chapter or state can be included in the design.
