### Amendment 1

All conference attendees, including guests, parents, and children, must wear a conference identification badge at all times. **OFFICIAL CONFERENCE  
ATTIRE GUIDELINES**  
(2015 - 2016 School Year)

**COMPETITION ATTIRE**

Shirt or blouse: official TSA shirt (royal blue)  
Pants or skirt: gray  
Socks: black or dark blue (males only)  
Shoes: black dress shoes (unacceptable: athletic shoes, army boots, combat, or work boots)  
Sandals: females only may wear black open-toe shoes or sandals

*Required for middle school or high school level Chapter Team only, but may be worn for other competitions if preferred by contestant:*

Blazer: navy blue with official TSA patch  
Tie: scarlet red imprinted with official TSA logo (males only)
