**Type of volunteers needed:** Judges and other volunteers are needed for various competitions and activities at TSA state conferences

**Location:** Locations throughout the United States; information about TSA state conferences is available at <http://tsaweb.org/state-conferences>.

**Date:** TSA state conferences take place between mid-February and early May.

**Time needed:** Varies at each conference; approximately 6-8 hours

**Description:** TSA state conferences have a variety of volunteer opportunities that are determined separately at the state level. These may include such activities as event judging, event set up, or interest session presentation.

**Skills needed:** An interest in STEM education or careers (engineering degree not required).
