



The App Challenge, part of Verizon Innovative Learning, is a nationwide contest in which middle and high school students are challenged to develop concepts for mobile apps that solve a problem in their community. The challenge is a unique, hands-on activity that teaches collaboration, critical thinking, problem solving, and entrepreneurship, as well as STEM (science, technology, engineering, and math) skills and coding.

Type of volunteers needed: Judges for essays and/or videos that describe an app concept

Location: Anywhere – judging is done via an electronic portal

Date: Judging happens over the period November 21st – December 19th

Time needed: 2-4 hours

Description: Volunteers use an electronic rubric to evaluate short essays and/or short videos

Skills needed: An interest in STEM education or careers (engineering degree not required)
