Description: The Distinguished Alumni Award is presented to a TSA alumni based on his or her demonstrated commitment and service to TSA beyond high school graduation. The recipient is recognized at the national TSA conference.

Who Qualifies: TSA alumni who meet these criteria:

- 1) Graduated from high school at least three years prior to the current year
- 2) Was a member in good standing with TSA for a minimum of two years
- 3) Actively participated in TSA after graduation, as evidenced by attendance at TSA conferences, membership on TSA committees, judging of student events, or other service of value to TSA.

Who Can Nominate: adult members of TSA, including corporate members, teachers/advisors, and administrators; and fellow TSA alumni
