

# National TSA Alumni/Alumnae Association Collegiate Scholarship Application



## OVERVIEW

The National TSA Alumni/Alumnae Scholarship is awarded annually to one TSA alumnus or alumna for financial support.

## CRITERIA AND REQUIREMENTS

- Applicant must be enrolled as a full-time student working toward the completion of an undergraduate degree.
- Applicant must have at least one semester remaining in the undergraduate degree to be eligible.
- Applicant must have a minimum GPA of 2.5.
- Applicant must be a TSA alumnus/alumna.
- Applicant must demonstrate involvement in TSA since becoming an alumnus/alumna.
- Applicant must submit a completed application packet with the required deliverables by the deadline stated in the Timeline section. Only one application packet should be submitted.

## DELIVERABLES

- Completed scholarship application
- Short essay
- Unofficial transcript
- Resume
- One letter of recommendation from an individual affiliated with TSA (e.g., chapter advisor, conference director) who can comment on the applicant's involvement in TSA as an alumnus/alumna. **Note:** Letter cannot be from a current student member of TSA.

## TIMELINE

- **May 1** – Scholarship applications and supporting documentation must be submitted online at [general@tsaweb.org](mailto:general@tsaweb.org).
- **May** – Scholarship applications and supporting documentation are reviewed by the selection committee.
- **June 16** – Scholarship applicants will be notified of a decision.

The scholarship recipient will be recognized at the National TSA Conference (scholarship winner is not required to attend).

National TSA will not be responsible for funding the recipient's attendance at the National TSA Conference.

## SELECTION PROCESS

The scholarship recipient is determined based on the criteria and the content of the deliverables included in the application packet. The selection is final and is not subject to review.

## FUNDING

The scholarship is a one-time amount of \$1,000. A check will be sent directly to the recipient's university/college financial aid office following the national TSA conference.
