

National TSA Alumni Association Collegiate Scholarship Application



OVERVIEW

The National TSA Alumni Association established the alumni scholarship program as a way to provide financial support to recognize the hard work and dedication of TSA alumni who work to continuously give back to TSA even though their time as a competitor has passed. The amount awarded for this scholarship is \$1,000 and will be distributed directly to the recipient's college or university's financial aid department.

CRITERIA AND REQUIREMENTS

- Applicant must be enrolled as a full-time student working towards the completion of an undergraduate degree.
- Applicant must have one semester remaining of their undergraduate degree to be eligible.
- Applicant must have a minimum GPA of 2.5.
- Applicant must be a member of the National TSA Alumni Association.
- Applicant demonstrates involvement in TSA since becoming an alumni.
- Applicant must submit a completed application packet with the required deliverables by the deadline stated in the timelines section. Please only submit one application packet with all required deliverables.
- Applicant may not be currently serving as a member of the National TSA Alumni Council.

DELIVERABLES

- Completed scholarship application
- Short Essay
- Unofficial transcript
- Resume
- One letter of recommendation from an individual affiliated with TSA (e.g. chapter advisor, conference director) who can speak to your involvement as an alumni. **Note:** Letter cannot be from a current student member of TSA.

TIMELINE

- **May 1** – Scholarship applications and supporting documentation must be submitted online at general@tsaweb.org
- **May** – Scholarship applications and supporting documentation are reviewed by the selection committee
- **June 16** – Scholarship applicants will be notified of decision.

The scholarship recipient will be recognized at the National TSA Conference (scholarship winner is not required to attend). Scholarship funds will be distributed to the recipient's university in August.

SELECTION PROCESS

The award reception is determined based on the criteria and the content of the deliverables included in the application package. The selection is final and is not subject to review.

FUNDING

The awarded amount of the scholarship is a one-time amount of \$1,000. The funds will be released directly to the recipient's university/college's financial aid office for distribution. The recipient will be notified on the date mentioned above in the timeline section, pending no complications. The recipient will also be recognized at the National TSA Conference, but is not required to attend to receive the scholarship. The National TSA Alumni Association will not be responsible for funding the recipient's attendance to the National TSA Conference.
