DESCRIPTION

The Honorary Lifetime Achievement Award, the highest recognition award in TSA, is given to an individual who has supported TSA in significant ways for a minimum of five years and who can be expected to have continued interest in TSA and its activities. Both past and current contributions are considered. Current members of the TSA, Inc. Board of Directors cannot be nominated during their respective terms of office. The recipient is recognized at the national TSA conference..

WHO QUALIFIES

Adults who meet these criteria:

1. Have a record of significant support of and association with TSA for a minimum of five years
2. Exhibit a desire for continued involvement in TSA and its activities.

WHO CAN NOMINATE

Only TSA state advisors, TSA corporate members, and members of the TSA, Inc. Board of Directors are eligible to nominate individuals for this award.
