*Tax exempt documents from your home state will not be accepted by the hotels.

*National TSA is not responsible for tax exemption certificates, certification, or status. Schools without a Florida tax exemption certificate will be responsible for all taxes. (do NOT bring the application to the hotels – they must be filed with the Florida Department of Revenue for certification.) The application process can take up to 8-12 weeks, so plan ahead!
