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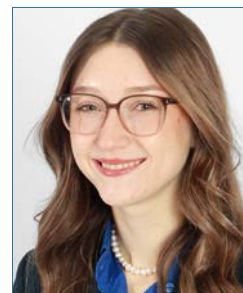

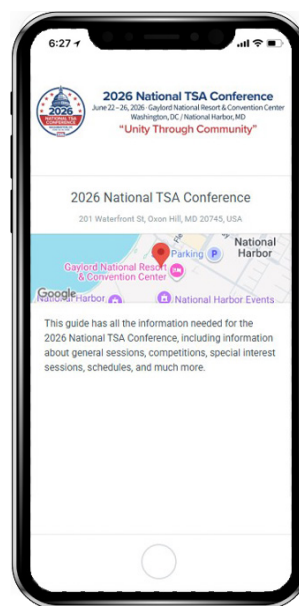

All general sessions will take place in the **Potomac Ballroom** at the Gaylord National Resort & Convention Center. Please be aware that the ballroom will be at full capacity during every general session. If you plan on sitting with a group, be sure your group is together prior to entering the ballroom. Saving seats will not be allowed. Livestreaming will be available on the conference app.

Opening General Session – General Session I

Tuesday, June 23; 9:00 AM – 11:00 AM

The 2026 National TSA Conference will open with the Parade of State Flags ceremony that includes a presentation of colors by the South County High School JROTC. The National Anthem will be performed by past National TSA Officer, Staci Davis, and her daughters – Faith Ann and Laney Davis – who are current TSA members. Several special presentations will follow, including the recognition of the 2026 Forward to Fifty State Delegations. National TSA officer candidates will deliver their campaign speeches. Doors will open at 8:00 AM.

Recognition Assembly – General Session II

Wednesday, June 24; 9:00 AM – 11:00 AM

Join us as we recognize members and advisors for their accomplishments. A variety of special awards, including Chapter Advisor of the Year will be presented. A new TEAMS partnership will be announced. Qualified corporate members and state advisors will receive recognition for years of service. National TSA officer candidates will answer extemporaneous questions during the session. Doors will open at 8:00 AM.

Business Meeting – General Session III

Thursday, June 25; 9:00 AM – 11:00 AM

Voting Delegate Seating; 7:00 AM – 7:30 AM

TSA's annual business meeting includes the election of national TSA officers by the voting delegates and the Parade of State Presidents. Doors will open at 7:00 AM for voting delegates and at approximately 8:45 AM for general seating.

Awards Ceremony – General Session IV

Friday, June 26; 7:30 AM – 10:30 AM

The highlight of the national conference is the awards ceremony, which recognizes all national competitive event finalists. The ceremony begins with a special performance of America the Beautiful. Trophies are awarded to the top three finalists in each competition. Finalist pins are awarded to the top ten competition finalists and their chapter advisors. Doors will open at 6:30 AM.

***No bags larger than the TSA drawstring backpack will be permitted at any of the general sessions. All bags are subject to inspection. National TSA is not responsible for lost or stolen items.*

Dress Code

Everyone who attends the National TSA Conference, including parents, guests, and children must be registered for the conference. All must comply with the TSA Dress Code policy.* Registrants must wear official conference identification name badges at all times.

COMPETITION ATTIRE

Shirt: official royal blue TSA shirt

Pants, or at least knee-length Skirt: gray

- *Unacceptable:* jeans; jeggings; leggings; baggy pants; exterior pocket pants; shorts

Shoes: black dress shoes worn with black or dark blue socks, hosiery (optional):

- open-toed shoes or sandals are acceptable
- *Unacceptable:* athletic shoes; flip-flops; military boots; or work boots

Required additional attire for Middle and High School Chapter Team event

Blazer: navy blue with official TSA patch

Tie: official TSA tie (males)

- Females are not penalized for wearing the official TSA tie to Chapter Team or any other competitive event.

Above attire may be worn for other competitions if preferred by event participants.

GENERAL SESSION ATTIRE

Shirt: the official TSA shirt (royal blue) is preferred; button-down shirt or a polo/golf shirt

- *Unacceptable:* t-shirts; halter tops; tank tops

Pants, or at least knee-length Dress or Skirt

- *Unacceptable:* jeans; jeggings; leggings; baggy pants; exterior pocket pants; shorts

Optional Blazer: navy blue with official TSA patch

Optional Tie: official TSA tie

Shoes: dress shoes worn with dark socks, hosiery (optional):

- open-toed shoes or sandals are acceptable
- *Unacceptable:* athletic shoes; flip-flops; military boots; or work boots

CASUAL ATTIRE

Appropriate t-shirts, shorts, or jeans

Casual attire **may not** be worn at competitions or general sessions.

*Registered parents, guests, and children who are not compliant with General Session Attire and who wish to attend the Awards Ceremony, may be asked to sit in a designated section, if permitted entry.

Approved by the TSA, Inc. Board of Directors. The above supersedes any other dress code prior to September 24, 2022.

Code of Conduct

This Code of Conduct applies to **all persons** attending the national TSA conference, including, but not limited to, all student members, advisors, alumni, parents, volunteers, and guests. All attendees are expected to conduct themselves in a polite, civil, and respectful manner towards others, and must comply with all applicable laws.

1. Unacceptable behavior will not be tolerated, such as the following:
 - abusive language
 - bullying
 - discrimination
 - threatening behavior
 - sexual harassment
 - causing physical harm
2. No alcoholic beverages, narcotics, firearms, or weapons, in any form, shall be possessed by attendees at any time, under any circumstances.
3. All student attendees must keep their advisor informed of their activities and/or whereabouts at all times.
4. Attendees should be prompt and prepared for all activities.
5. Attendees should be financially prepared for any unexpected expense.
6. Attendees shall be off the Gaylord National Resort & Convention Center convention center grounds by curfew or immediately following the last scheduled event.
7. No student attendee shall leave the conference hotels or Gaylord National Resort & Convention Center unless permission has been received from his or her chapter advisor.
8. Attendees are required to attend all general sessions and activities assigned, including competitive events, meetings, etc.
9. Identification (conference name badges) must be worn and be visible on a TSA lanyard by all conference attendees at the Gaylord National Resort & Convention Center.
10. **National TSA Dress Code** must be followed by all attendees.
11. All conference attendees must follow facility guidelines for adhering signs, notices, posters, etc. to walls, doors, or any facility surface. There shall be no defacing of public property. Any damages to the property or furnishings in the hotel rooms or buildings must be paid for by the individual(s) or chapter(s) responsible.
12. No helium or water balloons are permitted at the conference.
13. Attendees violating or ignoring any of the conduct rules will subject their entire delegation to being unseated and their candidates or competitive event participants being disqualified. Individual attendees may be sent home immediately at their own expense.
14. Curfews will be enforced. All student attendees will be in their

assigned hotel rooms by the announced curfew times.

15. The TSA, Inc. Executive Committee reserves the right to dismiss any person from the conference for inappropriate actions.

Advisors

1. Advisors shall conduct periodic meetings with their student attendees for the purpose of reviewing conference activities, obtaining progress reports, emphasizing time schedules, sharing successes, and overall, to ensure that the students are taking full advantage of the conference and its activities.
2. Advisors shall keep an agenda of their own schedule and give it to their student attendees, along with contact information, so that the advisor may be reached during the conference at any time.
3. Each advisor shall be responsible for ensuring that all student attendees adhere to all conduct practices and procedures, as published in this document.
4. Chapter advisors will be responsible for their student attendees' conduct.
5. The rules, as stated in this Code of Conduct and in the National TSA Dress Code, apply to advisors and parents as well as students.

Safety and Security

The safety and security of all persons who attend the conference is of the utmost concern to the governing body of TSA. There are numerous security guards, provided by the Gaylord National Resort & Convention Center and TSA, who work closely with local law enforcement. In addition, daily advisor update meetings provide information on how to report any security issues that may arise. As a necessary precaution, TSA enforces the following procedures:

- All participants must register for the conference.
- Identification (name badge) must be worn and be visible on a TSA lanyard by all conference attendees at the Gaylord National Resort & Convention Center after June 26th.
- The mandatory student attendee curfew is 10:00pm.
- The conference is not "open to the public."
- The TSA Code of Conduct must be followed by all attendees.

Personal items brought to the conference for use at the conference are the sole responsibility of the attendee who chooses to bring the items. If a participant chooses to bring items of value, s/he is responsible for their safekeeping at all times, including any item of monetary or personal value and items used in competitive events. TSA accepts no responsibility for replacement of lost, misplaced, or stolen items and will not replace such items. This policy applies to all attendees and includes the conference management team and event coordinators.

Competitive Event Information

Testing Events

AnswerWrite is the platform for onsite tests. Members MUST know their TSA Student Member Site ID# and password to access [AnswerWrite](#).

To take an onsite team event test at the conference, each team member will access the AnswerWrite platform, as described above.

Individual participants, or each team member, must bring to the testing site:

- One (1) laptop or tablet (personal or school-issued) capable of networking via Wi-Fi and able to run solely on battery power for up to two (2) consecutive hours. Chrome is the preferred browser.
- Optional: One (1) mouse
- Two (2) sharpened No.2 pencils

External keyboards and monitors are not permitted.

Competitive event onsite uploads

Competitors who advance to the semifinal level in MS Audio Podcasting, MS Promotional Marketing, MS Technical Design, HS Audio Podcasting, and HS On Demand Video, MUST access JudgePro (National TSA's scoring system) to upload semifinalist entries.

Members MUST know their TSA Student Member Site ID# and password to access [JudgePro](#).

Competition Requirements

Advisors and students must be aware of the [competition requirements](#) for the national TSA conference. These include, but are not limited to, the following:

- A laptop or tablet is required for “written” tests and the preliminary round submission for HS On Demand Video and MS Vlogging.
- The laptop or tablet must be Wi-Fi enabled and able to run solely on battery power for up to two (2) consecutive hours.
- The test platform requires that students know their TSA Student Member ID# and password.

Semifinalists and Finalists

Semifinalists

Semifinalist lists (in random order) will be posted online via the website, [TSAweb.org](#), and on the TSA Mobile App as competitions are judged.

A semifinalist is an individual or a team that qualifies to compete in the semifinal round of a event—which usually involves up to twelve competitors—in order to place as a finalist (top ten).

Awards Ceremony Attendance

Attendance at the Awards Ceremony on Friday, June 26, requires conference registration. Attendees must be registered for the conference no later than Thursday, June 25, at 5:00 PM.

National TSA Officer Elections

The election of the 2026-2027 national officer team will be conducted through the TSA conference app. This voting method allows for efficient run-offs and for the results of the election to remain anonymous until they are announced at the awards general session. Voting delegates must have a fully charged cell phone for the business meeting, during which the election will be held.

Conference app voting requires that:

1. All voting delegates be present at the business meeting.
2. Each voting delegate use his/her charged cell phone to vote.
3. All voting delegates have access to data via their cell phone, as WIFI will not be provided during the voting session.

Officer Candidate Campaign

Meet the 2026-2027 national TSA officer candidates at the TSA Meet and Greet on Wednesday, June 24th, from 1:00 PM to 5:00 PM. Candidates will be at their campaign tables in the Potomac Ballroom Pre-function of the Gaylord National Resort & Convention Center. Voting for the candidates will take place on Thursday, June 25th, during the annual business meeting in Potomac Ballroom A. Voting delegate seating takes place from 7:00 AM to 7:30 AM.

Chartered states have one vote for each state officer (six maximum), plus two additional votes for each affiliated chapter in the state delegation in attendance. Delegates must be present to vote. A parliamentarian will be present. The election of the 2026-2027 national officer team will take place through voting via the conference app. Voting delegates must have a fully charged cell phone with them for the meeting.

Members interested in formally proposing a resolution at this conference must follow the guidelines that appear in the TSA bylaws. All resolution forms must be submitted to National TSA President, Sen Yakandawala, by 12:00 PM, Wednesday, June 24th.
