



The TSA VEX Robotics Competition (VRC) and the TSA VEX IQ Challenge (VIQC) provide students with exciting opportunities to learn about science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM). These two competitions complement the technology-oriented events offered by TSA, and deliver the action-packed experience of VEX. The format of the TSA VEX competitions allows team members to participate in VEX events, as well as TSA competitive events and activities at the national TSA conference.

Type of volunteers needed: Individuals to assist VEX staff on site at the National TSA Conference

Location: On site at the national TSA conference

Date: TBD per conference; typically one to three days during the national TSA conference, which occurs near the end of June and runs for five days

Time needed: approximately 5-8 hours

Description: Volunteers will assist the VEX staff as needed

Skills needed: Interest in robotics is preferred, but not required
