



Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Can I register to compete at a host site through the TEAMS registration system?

A: No. The TEAMS registration system does not allow for selection of a host site. When you register for TEAMS, you agree to participate in the competition, whether at your school or at a host site. If you are interested in competing at a host site, you must submit a Host Site Request form, which will be found in the confirmation email you receive once your TEAMS registration is complete.

Q: How do I submit a Host Site Request form?

A: Follow these steps:

1. Review the available host sites on the TEAMS website.
2. Register for the TEAMS competition.
3. Once registration is complete, you will receive a confirmation email.
4. Click on the link in the confirmation email and complete the Host Site Request form.
5. The host that you select on the request form will contact you regarding competition at the site. To compete at the site, you must receive confirmation of availability from the host. If the host site is not available, you must conduct the competition at your school.

Q: Will the multiple-choice TEAMS exam be administered through an online testing system?

A: Yes. Teams will take the exam via an online testing system. Wi-Fi/internet will be provided so that teams may log into the testing system.

Q: How will the design/build challenge be judged?

A: Entries will be submitted to TSA by the host for judging.

Q: Will I receive my scores at the host site?

A: No. Scores will be posted in April 2024 after rankings are available.

Q: Who should I contact if I have a question regarding the host site?

A: Contact the host site directly with any questions regarding competition day arrangements.

Q: What do I need to bring to the host site?

A: Coaches are responsible for providing the design/build materials for each team. Hosts may require each team to bring a tablet/laptop to complete the multiple-choice exam.

Q: What happens if my team(s) cannot attend the host site on the scheduled competition day or the host site must cancel the competition?

A: Coaches are responsible for scheduling their students for the TEAMS competition. If the competition is canceled for any reason (including weather or changes to in-person learning) it is the responsibility of the coach to reschedule the competition at their own school. TEAMS registration fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.
